REMINDERS FOR USAGE OF THE SWIMMING POOL & SUNDECK

All Health Club Facilities (including Pool & Sundeck)

- No food is allowed in any Health Club facility.
- All beverages must be in covered, non-breakable containers in all areas.
- Smoking is prohibited in all Common Areas of the building, including the pool deck and upper sun deck, and Fitness Center.
- Pets are not allowed on the entire 56th floor.
- Proper attire must be worn specific to each facility, and cover-ups and footwear must be worn between the facilities and individual units.
- Footwear must be worn in all interior areas of the 56th floor.
- Radios, CD players, cassette players, or other such devices must be used with earphones in all common areas.

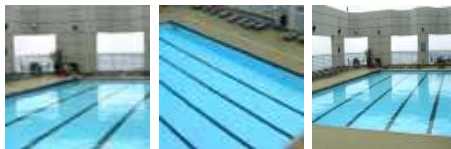
Swimming Pool

- The number of guests permitted at the swimming pool is limited to four (4) guests per unit.
- Posted hours of use must be observed.
- Posted Illinois Department of Public Health regulations must be observed.
- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at the pool and sundeck areas.
- A shower should be taken before entering the pool, and again after the use of sun tan lotion before entering the pool.
- Long hair must be contained in a bathing cap, braided, or gathered in a hair device.
- Proper swimming attire must be worn when using the pool. Under shorts and cut-off jeans are not allowed.
- Children not toilet trained must wear tight-fitting rubber or plastic pants in the pool.
- Everyone must be dried off before exiting the pool/whirlpool/locker room area.
- Pool chairs and sundeck chairs may not be saved.

- No playpens, bicycles or wagons are permitted on the pool deck.
- Behaving in such a way that disrupts the use, safety, and enjoyment of the pool by other people will not be tolerated, and offenders will be asked to leave.

Sundecks

Adults must accompany children under 16 years of age at all times on the upper sundeck.



ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH: PATRON REGULATIONS FOR SWIMMING POOLS

- Admission to the pool shall be refused to all persons having any contagious disease, infectious conditions such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesions, diarrhea, vomiting, inflamed eyes, ear discharges, or any other condition which has the appearance of being infectious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages, or other bandages of any kind shall also be refused admittance. A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the pool area.
- The pool water is not suitable for drinking. Avoid swallowing pool water.
- Littering is prohibited. In addition, no food, drink, gum or tobacco is allowed in other than specially designated and controlled sections of the pool area. Glass containers are prohibited.
- All persons are encouraged to take a shower before entering the pool area.

- Personal conduct within the pool facility must be such that the safety of self and others is not jeopardized. No running, boisterous or rough play, except supervised water sports, is permitted.
- Only clean footwear, baby strollers, or wheelchairs are allowed in the pool area or bathhouse.
- Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose or otherwise introducing contaminants into the pool is not permitted.
- Glass, soap, or other material which might create hazardous conditions or interfere with efficient operation of the swimming pool shall not be permitted in the swimming pool or on the pool deck.
- All apparel worn in the pool shall be clean.
- All children who are not toilet-trained shall wear tightly fitting rubber or plastic pants.
- Diving in water less than five feet deep is not permitted except when allowed for competitive swimming and training.
- Caution shall be exercised in the use of diving facilities.
- Swimming is prohibited at outdoor swimming pools when thunder is heard or lightning is seen, including a 15-minute period after the last lightning or thunder is detected.
- If present, lifeguards are responsible for enforcing safety rules and responding to emergencies. Parents or guardians should supervise their children.
- No one should swim alone.
- The pool management has the authority to implement and enforce rules that are more stringent or that supplement those listed here.

FREE SWIM

The swimming pool is scheduled for **FREE SWIM on Saturdays 3:00 PM - 5:00 PM.**

Lap swimming is not permitted during free swim, so lap swimmers should plan to swim prior to 3:00 PM on Saturdays or after 5:00 PM. Your cooperation is appreciated!
